COURSE

Sing for Pleasure's popular course for talented young singers from the West Midlands is back. Led by experienced teachers and choir leaders, this five day, non-residential summer school aims to develop choral and musicianship skills through a wide range of repertoire, fun singing games and musical activities. The course is open to any child aged between 9 and 13 years. The ability to sight read is not essential but pupils should have experience of singing in a choir or be learning to play an instrument.

Children can come in a group with their teacher or as an individual. Plenty of staff will be on hand to supervise those who attend without an adult. There is no cost for accompanying teachers.

TIMING

Each day starts with registration and warm ups at 9.30am and ends at 3.15pm. The course ends with a concert on Friday at 2.00pm for family and friends.

VENUE

The Forest Arts Centre in Walsall is home to the Walsall Music Education Hub which is kindly supporting this event. The venue is well situated, close to J10 of the M6 and has plenty of parking.

COST

The course is being generously supported by John Lewis Partnership. The cost per child is £50 for the week which includes all activities, music and refreshments. Children should bring a packed lunch and bottled water each day.
